Details:

After several potential bidders expressed hesitation over using Joomla or suggested using a different solution, we have decided to amend the RFP to allow options besides Joomla.

We encourage all potential bidders to recommend and build their proposal based on the CMS solution (i.e. Joomla, Drupal, Plone, etc.), programming language (i.e. Ruby, Perl, Python, PHP, etc.), web framework (i.e. Rails, Catalyst, Rails, CakePHP, etc.), and/or open source database engine (i.e. PostgreSQL, MySQL, Firebird, etc.) they feel would best meet the Tribe's needs. Nevertheless, the solution should still run on Apache and Ubuntu. One further note: all custom code which is part of the solution will be considered "work for hire" and will belong to the Tribe.

Our interest is that the proposal meets the *functionality* specified in the RFP. How this functionality is implemented (using a different CMS, or custom developing the solution) is not as important.

The rest of the RFP still applies, including but not limited to the security requirements and functionality stated; however, portions specific to Joomla, PHP, and MySQL may be modified to adapt to bidder's recommended solution.
